Understanding the Progress Measure in 2018
The school progress measure is calculated by comparing the attainment of pupils at the end of Year 6 with the end of Year 2. A score of 0 means pupils in the school on average do as well as similar pupils nationally. A positive score means pupils in the school on average do better than similar pupils nationally. A negative score means pupils in the school do on average worse than similar pupils nationally.
