
Maths Number Cards & Activity Ideas

Cut out the number cards and use them to support your child to develop their number knowledge. Begin focusing on number cards 0-10, when confident progress to include cards 0-15, then 0-20.



Here are some ideas to try:

Recognising numbers:

- -Show them each card in a random order, can they tell you what number it is?
- -Have a <u>number hunt</u>, hide the cards then child to find cards and attempt to recognise!
- -<u>Display numbers</u> around the house, what number is on the fridge? (Remember to swap them around to challenge them!)
- -Look for numbers when <u>out and about</u> e.g. bus numbers, house numbers, prices in shops,

Ordering numbers:

- -Ask them to put the number cards in the correct order, what comes next? Support by saying the order aloud together to check, this often prompts them to correct a mistake!
- -Once ordered ask them to close their eyes and swap the order of some numbers, see if your child can spot the mistakes and correct them!

Saying 1 more or 1 less:

- -Begin by asking 1 more questions with numbers cards displayed in order (e.g. what is 1 more than 5?), then for a challenge ask child to turn around and answer it without looking at the cards!
- -Develop to ask 1 less questions, beginning with numbers 1-10, then to 20
