

Science

Our science topic this term is "My Body and our Senses." The children will be learning to name parts of the body and will learn some of the differences and similarities between humans and animals. The children will also investigate how we use senses to explore the world around us.

Computing

We will programme BeeBots as part of our coding work and send them off on adventures around the classroom. We will then develop our skills with paint programmes to explore changing colours, size and using various tools.

This term we will be thinking about rules and their importance especially as we settle into our new class. We will then look at how we can keep our bodies clean and healthy.

Art /D&T

The children will be using a variety of techniques and mediums to create self-portraits. They will also be introduced to various artists. In DT the children will learn to use a knife safely to cut fruit and vegetables. The children will then choose ingredients to design a "fruit face" of their own.

Geography/History

This term our Geography topic is all about our local area. We will be finding out about where we live and our journey to school. We will look at basic mapping skills and drawing maps.
